How to Enter

Draw and Notification of winner

The draw will commence at 11.30pm on Saturday 3rd February 2024 at the Kyneton Sheep Sale Yards, Saleyards Rd, Kyneton.

All eligible tickets will be included in all prize draws.

The winner will be notified by telephone and in writing by the Suffolk Sheep Breeders Association of Victoria. Prizes will be awarded to the individual(s) named on the official ticket. Prize notification letters are addressed to the primary ticket holder. It is the responsibility of the primary ticket holder to allocate the prize if necessary.
